

# Countermeasure against Covid-19 for Kavli IPMU conferences in October 11 (As from October 11, 2022)

The capacity of the Lecture Hall is limited to **60 people** under Covid-19 measure. Registration in advance is necessary. This number is based on the ventilation capacity of the room.

On the first day of your attendance, please pick your name tag and the tag holder in the lecture hall and wear it anytime to enter the Lecture Hall during the conference. This certifies that you have been registered and counted for the headcount up to 60 people.

**When you feel sick**, please report it to your organizer immediately. We have a waiting room (Seminar Room B: with capacity of 13 people in maximum) next to the Lecture Hall. You are requested to take an antigen test to confirm the condition.

When you have a fever of **37.5 Celsius (99.5 Fahrenheit) or higher**, you will be asked to leave, regardless of the antigen test result. Just in case, you might want to bring your own thermometer and first-aid medicines.

When we find an infection of covid-19 during the workshop, we might change the convening style to online only.

**Please abide by the covid-19 measures of Kavli IPMU.**

- **Sanitize your hands with alcohol frequently**
- **No eating /drinking in the Lecture Hall**
- **No eating in the open spaces in IPMU building**
