

## Countermeasure against Covid-19 for Kavli IPMU conferences (July, 2022)

The capacity of the Lecture Hall is limited to **30 people** under Covid-19 measure. Registration in advance is necessary. The entrance of the building is unlocked 30 minutes prior to the day program for 1 hour.

On the first day of your attendance, all the participants are requested to take a **covid-19 antigen test** to prove the negative test result to get in the conference room. The test kit is available for those who have completed the registration.

The test is a nasal swab-based method. Please allow **approximately 30 minutes** for taking your swab sample and doing the test to get the result.

**When you feel sick**, please report it to your organizer immediately. We have a waiting room (Seminar Room A) next to the Lecture Hall. You are requested to take another antigen test to confirm the condition.

When you have a fever of **37.5 Celsius (99.5 Fahrenheit) or higher**, you will be asked to leave, regardless of the antigen test result. Just in case, you might want to bring your own thermometer and first-aid medicines.

When we find an infection of covid-19 during the workshop, we will change the convening style to online only.

**Please abide by the covid-19 measures of Kavli IPMU.**

- **Keep social distancing**
- **Wear a mask always**
- **Sanitize your hands with alcohol frequently**
- **No eating /drinking in the Lecture Hall**
- **No eating in the IPMU building**
